As indicated in the header this agreement is a template- it is for review only; the incomplete sections will be completed by/with the chosen entity during contract negotiations. The Mapping Services Agreement and SOW are <u>not</u> to be completed and submitted with the bid; please submit requested edits if any. Please note that 1) some terms within the Mapping Services Agreement incorporate required flow downs and will not be able to be modified, and 2) Exhibits 5-9 cannot be modified. MassTech will discuss the Agreement further with the selected bidder(s) during contract negotiations.
